Technical:

Artist to provide:
3 piece band- guitar, bass, drums
3 vocals
2 piece “cocktail” drum kit
1 bass rig**
1 guitar rig**

****FOR FLY DATES: Presenter will need to provide the bass rig and guitar rig:**

Bass rig - any bass combo (or separate amp with a speaker cabinet) that is a minimum of 200 watts

Guitar rig – ideally any Fender-brand tube amp/speaker combo-cabinet of at least 50 watts

Please contact your agent to confirm this detail.

Presenter to provide:

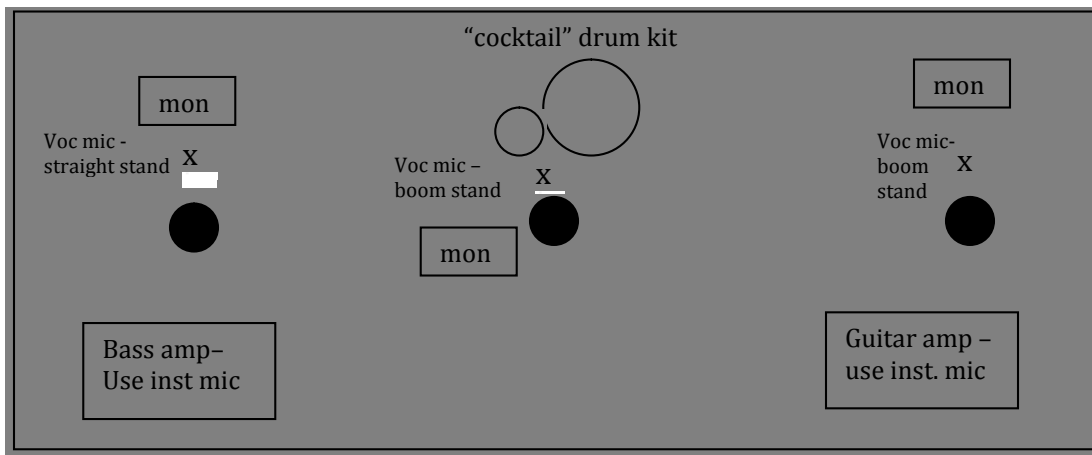
1. 1 hour for Artist to load-in, set-up and sound check prior to doors opening.
2. PA adequate for performance space.
3. General wash lighting adequate for performance space.
4. 3 vocal mics, two on boom stands (for guitarist and drummer) and one on a straight stand (for bassist).
5. 3 monitor wedges; one monitor mix is fine.
6. 5 instrument mics: one for guitar amp, one for bass amp. Please see note below regarding cocktail drum kit:

The cocktail drum kit is played while standing and is set up at the front of the stage between the bass player and guitar player. It is made up of a small snare drum, and a tall tom/bass drum. The tom is played from the top and the bass end is played with a kick pedal positioned under the drum. We have found that a bass drum mic under the kit, an over-head to cover the tom, and another over head to cover the snare works just fine. If that isn't practical, then 2 mics work- one over head and one under for the bass drum.

The cocktail kit fits in one bag that can be carried over his shoulder, so when it comes to loading in and storage it doesn't take up any more space than a couple of guitars.

Presenter to provide:

1. Dressing room – It doesn't have to be fancy, just a secure room large enough for 3 adults to change in and leave their personal items until load-out. Please provide a 12-pack of room- temperature bottled water and some healthy snacks.
2. Presenter to provide 3 non-smoking hotel rooms
3. Presenter to provide Artist with a healthy hot lunch or hot dinner, depending on performance time. The band members don't have any dietary restrictions or food allergies, but prefer to avoid fast food and pizza.

Merchandise:

Artist sells merchandise after the show and would like one 6' table for the merch set up. Artist will pay venue 10% of merch sales. If venue can provide a seller, Artist will pay 20%.
